City Centre

- Pray for one of our long-term guests who is again struggling with addiction. Pray that he returns to the Mission for our support and that he stays away from temptation.
- Pray for breakthrough with our many Muslim guests. Pray that practical needs like housing are met and that they recognise Jesus as Saviour.

Child and Family Centre, Govan

- Give thanks for our fellow "Missioners" from Edinburgh City Mission. They visited to see first-hand how the C&FC operates as they are looking at developing similar areas of ministry in Edinburgh.
- Pray for a single parent of two who has been attending our breakfast club, ESOL tuition, and our All Age Family Club. She is making great progress in her personal development and family life. She has now become a parent helper at our groups, and her self-confidence has increased significantly.
