#### **New Sermon Series**

#### The Bread Of Life - A Sermon Series On John 6

This Sunday we begin a new study on Jesus' most comforting and yet controversial sermon. In John 6 Jesus describes Himself as being the Bread of Life. Here He highlights who He is and what He's come to do - He's the One Who's come from Heaven to give life to anyone and everyone who receives Him It's the greatest news that anyone could possibly hear. However, we'll see that while this sermon encourages some to follow after Jesus it also causes others to walk away from Him. The question facing all who hear it are "Do we hear these as the words of eternal life or not?"

#### Comfortably Numb - A Sermon Series On Malachi

What does God have to say to His people when they've become indifferent to Him and lost any real enthusiasm for His cause? What does God have to say when His people may have orthodox beliefs but their worship lacks heart? What does God have to say to people who feel like life hasn't worked out the way that they hoped it would and who've grown numb toward Him as a result? This Sunday we begin a new series on the Prophecy of Malachi where God seeks to answer such questions as He reminds His disillusioned and discouraged people about His loving commitment to them and calls them to a renewed commitment to Him.

#### Safeguarding Training
