Hope For Hurting Hearts

This is a bible based approach developed by the Trauma Healing Institute to help people heal from suffering, whether its grief, loss of any kind, chronic ill health, abuse, lack of forgiveness, basically anything that causes your heart and spirit pain.

The 6 sessions are;

- *What is a wound of the heart*
- *What helps a heart wound heal?*
- *Why does God allow suffering?*
- *Loss, grief and bereavement*
- *Forgiveness*
- *Bringing it to the cross*

We meet in small groups to work through these issues. If you feel it would help you, or if you would like to be better able to help others who are suffering, please speak to Margaret Macleod or Heather Mackenzie who will together be facilitating the sessions.

We hope to start the next group after the October holidays and will confirm the time once we know when the people who wish to come are available as we want to make this as accessible as possible.
